

Admission to the Undergraduate Courses in MBBS/BDS/B.E/B. Pharmacy, Diploma in Engineering and Diploma in Pharmacy under “Self Financing Scheme” for the year 2012-2013

Applications from Mauritian students are invited in prescribed form for above – mentioned courses. Selected candidates will be allotted seats earmarked for foreign students.

Eligibility

- (1) MBBS/BDS : Minimum 60% aggregate in 10+2 examination of India or its equivalent (HSC / GCE A level) with Minimum 60% marks (B Grade) in Biology (Zoology, Botany), Physics and Chemistry and 50 (C Grade) in English.
- (2) BE : Minimum 60% aggregate in 10+2 examination of India or its equivalent (HSC/GCE A level) with Minimum 60% marks (B grade) in Physics, Chemistry, Maths and 50% (C Grade) in English.
- (3) B. Pharmacy,
Diploma in Pharmacy : Minimum 60% aggregate in 10+2 examination of India or its equivalent (HSC / GCE A level) with Minimum 60%marks (B Grade) in Physics, Biology (Botany & Zoology) and Chemistry and 50% marks (C Grade) in English.
- 4) Diploma in Engineering : Minimum of 60% aggregate marks (B Grade) with at least 60% marks in Physics, Chemistry, Maths in the first attempt & 50% (C Grade) in English in 10th (O level) as well as in 12th Grade Examination.
